COMPETITION WEIGHT

Please indicate your weight class on the application.

Masters, you must register with your current weight.

NOTE: Weight classes listed on the Athlete Entry Form are MAXIMUM allowable weight for each division.

Example: If you are 18 (as of the 7/25/17 age determination date), & you register in Men's Youth 17-18 division at 141 lbs, then you must weigh OVER 132 lbs (the previous weight class) and NO MORE than 141 lbs.

If you are unable to compete in any of the official contested weight classes (listed on the Athlete Entry Form), you may be able to box in a matched bout, however, matched bouts are not guaranteed.

Pre-registered weights can be changed during Check-In.

All Weights Are Final On Tuesday, July 25th after Coaches meeting ends

CHECK-IN

Monday, July 24th from Noon to 6:00 pm

Tuesday, July 25th from 7:00 am to 3:00 pm **Check-in closes promptly at 3:00 pm July 25th**

Coaches must check your athletes in to ensure they are entered into the draw.

The first 500 coaches who check in receive a ticket for a free gift to be distributed after coaches meeting.

USA coaches must present their current-dated red Coach's book

International coaches must present current-dated credentials, in order to register.

All registered coaches & officials will receive wrist bands/credentials at check-in.

Master Boxers also check in during the times noted above.

Prior to check-in, coaches must ensure all their athletes have a valid 2017 boxing passbook

MEETINGS

Officials Meeting is 4:15 pm Tuesday evening inside the Arena.
Masters Meeting is 6:00pm Tuesday evening, inside the Arena.
Coaches Meeting is 6:30pm Tuesday evening, inside the Arena.

TESTING / CLINIC

Elevation testing for Level 1 officials to become Level 2 will be at 3:00 pm Tuesday evening inside the Arena.

*****IMPORTANT CHANGE**: Due to USA Boxing's requirement for coaches to complete certification online, the Chief of Officials has determined there will be no coaches clinic at the tournament.***

MANDATORY EQUIPMENT & ATTIRE

Non-Master boxers – must provide USA Boxing-approved competition headgear (open face or cheek)

Master Boxers - must provide their own USA Boxing Masters Approved competition headgear.

Teams from outside the U.S. may use AIBA or USA Boxing approved competition headgear.

Form-fitted mouthpiece (no red or pink), Protective cup

Handwraps – Gauze and regular handwraps with Velcro closure are allowed.

Boxing trunks must have a contrasting waistband from jersey, with no fringe or sequins

GLOVES

Boxers up to 141 lbs.: 10 oz. Over 141 lbs.: 12 oz. Masters: 16 oz.

COMPETITION INFO & ROUND TIMES *

Wednesday – Friday competition has 2 (two) daily sessions - - 11:00 am & 6:00 pm

One Championship session on Saturday begins at 11:00 am

Every session will have 6 boxing rings

Pee Wee: 8, 9, 10 3 – 1 minute **Bantam: 11-12** 3 – 1 minute

Intermediate: 13-14 3 – 1.5 minutes **Junior: 15-16** 3 – 2 minutes

Youth Women: 17-18 3 – 2 minutes **Youth Men: 17-18** 3 – 2 minutes

Elite Women: 19-40 3 – 2 minutes (finals 3 – 3's) **Elite Men: 19-40** 3 – 2 minutes (finals 3 – 3's)

Master: Masters 50+ years 3 – 1 minute rounds.

Masters 35-49 years 3 – 2 minute rounds only if following 3 conditions are met:

1. both boxers are less than 50 years of age, and
2. both boxers agree to 2 minutes, and
3. both boxers notify the timekeeper just prior to stepping into the ring.

Otherwise, the rounds will be 1 minute in length.

No Master rounds will be greater than 1.5 minutes in length.

* Ringside reserves the right to adjust the competition round times due to number of entries

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

There is a Zero Tolerance Policy for verbal &/or physical abuse/intimidation by any athlete, coach, official or spectator. Violations of this policy are grounds for immediate removal from the tournament and arena.

Bout sheets are posted by 6:00 am Wednesday through Saturday, on www.ringside.com/tournaments.

WEIGH-INS & PHYSICALS - Wednesday through Saturday

Athletes must be at the Event Center at 7:00 am for weigh-ins every day they are scheduled to box
Boxers weigh in every morning they compete. No coaches will be allowed at the scales.

A boxer who is greater than 2 pounds over the weight limit, is disqualified without further recourse.

If a boxer is 2 lbs or less over the weight limit, they will have until 9:00 am to make weight.

If the boxer still does not make weight, they will not be able to compete.

Trial scales are available throughout the tournament in women's/men's restrooms by venue box office.

Mandatory Meeting - Tuesday, July 25th at 6:30 pm, in the Events Center

YOU MUST CONFIRM YOUR BOXER IS IN THE RIGHT DIVISION AND WEIGHT CLASS AT THIS MEETING

After verifying your athlete's entry information is all correct, free gifts are distributed to
the first 500 coaches who checked in and have the ticket they received at check-in.

U.S. coaches must present a current-dated RED Coaches Book, obtained in advance, to work a corner.

Coaches outside the US must present current-dated credentials to work a corner.
